1. Attendance and Participation

- ✔ Attend at least **80%** of each class to be marked present. In some classes this is a mandatory requisite to pass the course.
 - ✔ Being present means **engaging actively** — just logging in or signing your name is not enough.
 - ⊘ Do not sign in for others or ask others to sign in for you.

2. Academic Integrity (see also AI policy of UNIPD and POD)

- ✔ Use AI tools like **ChatGPT** to **support** your study (brainstorm ideas, clarify concepts).
 - ⊘ **Do not submit AI-generated content** without personal understanding and rephrasing.
 - ✔ Always submit work that truly reflects **your own thinking**.

3. Collaboration

- ✔ You can **discuss** homework with classmates!
 - ✔ Each student must **write their own version**, based on their individual understanding.
 - ✔ Everyone is expected to make a fair contribution to the group work.
 - ⊘ Copy-paste between group members is not allowed.

- ✔ Treat everyone — classmates, professors, staff — with **respect**.

- ⊘ Disruptive, offensive, or discriminatory behavior will not be tolerated.
